

CDEA-NH Employees Choice Award Criteria

An award given every twelve or more months to recognize a supervisor, district supporter, or volunteer acting independently or affiliated with any agency/organization or conservation district who is doing an outstanding job in making the district employee's job easier on a statewide basis, helps obtain one or more New Hampshire Association of Conservation District's (NHACD) goals, and assists in expanding employee professional development opportunities and effectiveness. The recipient can be an individual(s) or group(s) and may be recognized more than once. Nominations must be made through an employee member (part or full time); nominee must not be a conservation district employee. Nominations must address in narrative form questions put forth by the Conservation Districts Employee Association-New Hampshire (CDEA-NH), based upon the National Conservation Districts Employee Association award forms, related to the nominee's professionalism, excellence, conservation leadership capabilities, and dedication; not exceed two pages in length; shall refer to nominee(s) as 'nominee' or 'applicant' and not by the individual's name; be received by the Judging Committee Chair no later than March 15. All submissions will be discussed and voted on by employee members. The value of the award(s) given will be at the discretion of the employee members and may vary with each award given. The award will be presented at the CDEA Annual Meeting.

Conservation District Employee Award Criteria

An award which may be given annually to recognize a district employee who assists in expanding employee development opportunities, makes district employees jobs easier on a statewide basis, and helps obtain one or more of New Hampshire Conservation Partnership goals. The recipient shall be a full or part time district employee. They may be recognized more than once. Nominations shall be submitted to a judging committee whose chair shall be an associate member of CDEA-NH. No employee member will hold a position on the judging committee. The nominations must address in narrative form questions put forth by the Conservation Districts Employee Association-New Hampshire (CDEA-NH), based upon the National Conservation Districts Employees Association award forms, related to the nominee's professionalism, excellence, conservation leadership capabilities, and dedication; not to exceed two pages in length; shall refer to nominee(s) as 'nominee' or 'applicant' and not by the individual's name; be received by the Judging Committee Chair no later than March 15. The CDEA president/vice president shall choose the presenter of the award and all decisions will be final. The award will be presented at the CDEA Annual Meeting. The award recipient will automatically become a nominee for the regional level award.
